



- d. Is the voluntary nature of participation ensured? Is information provided about the possibility of withdrawing from participation without consequences?
- e. Are participants informed in advance about participation in the study and its content? Is detailed information provided on the objectives and procedures of the study, the duration of the study, the burdens and risks associated with specific study procedures, and the compensation and other promises made to participants?
- f. In what form do participants declare their willingness to participate (“informed consent”)? Please submit the wording of the participant information. Does it list the planned data protection measures? Does it confirm the voluntary nature of participation in the study and the right to withdraw the declaration of willingness? If the participants (and/or their legal representatives) submit a written declaration, please also submit this in full. Does the declaration of willingness clearly refer to the participant information? In the case of a verbal declaration of willingness by the participants to the trial management, please indicate how this is done and how it is documented.

g. Do the participants receive complete information and the opportunity to ask questions after the study? Please submit the text of the informed consent form. In the case of an oral explanation, please state the wording as precisely as possible.

h. How long will the data be stored?

i. Until when can participants request that their data be deleted?
